Intercessory Prayer for the Nations

As pastors, missionaries, global workers and ministry leaders, we know PRAYER is one of the most powerful weapons we have against the forces of evil. It gives us a way to communicate with God directly and intercede on behalf of others.

Praying for the nations is one of the most important things we can and should be doing on a regular basis. It's our opportunity to make a difference in the world and be a part of God's plan for redemption.

Missional intercessory prayer is so important because it give us the chance to be a part of something bigger than ourselves. It gives us the opportunity to join with God in His work of restoring creation.

Allow me to share the following prayer points and encourage you to increase your prayer efforts for our Arizona Ministry Network missionary family and for the nations of the world.





Prayer Points for the Nations

#1 - Desire for the One True God

Jesus Christ is the only one who can fulfill the deepest desires of the human heart. It's this desire that needs to be awakened in the hearts of the nations. Pray for the true desire to be made known.

"And I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, saith the Lord of Hosts." Haggai 2:7

#2 - Pray for Forgiveness

Pray for a spirit of repentance to rest on the nation and ask God to forgive the sins of that nation and to heal the land.

"If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land." 2 Chronicles 7:14

#3 - Cover Spiritual Leaders

Pray for the laborers in the field. Cover the ministers, pastors, church leaders of that nation. Many in ministry are attacked daily and need prayer covering.

"Then he said to his disciples, The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." Matthew 9:37-38

#4 - Let the Gospel Go Forth

Pray for the lost to be saved and for the gospel to go forth in boldness, and power. Pray for any form of hindrance to stop and that His word would be preached.

"As for other matters, brothers and sisters, pray for us that the message of the Lord may spread rapidly and be honored, just as it was with you." 2 Thessalonians 3:1

#5 - Pray for the Persecuted

Pray for your fellow brothers and sisters that are being persecuted for their faith. Pray for protection and for them to be hidden from those who persecute them. Pray for strength and mercy.

"Praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints." Ephesians 6:18

#6 - Unity

Unity goes beyond our geographical boundaries. Pray for unity within the brethren, unity of the churches in that nation, unity within the saints in surrounding nations, and unity of the whole body of Christ.

"I appeal to you, dear brothers and sisters, by the authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, to live in harmony with each other. Let there be no divisions in the church. Rather, be of one mind, united in thought and purpose." 1 Corinthians 1:10

#7 - Governmental Leaders

Pray for their salvation. Pray for God to keep their heart pure and remove any corruption. Pray for wisdom to make godly laws that will bring blessing to that nation. Pray for the right people to be elected and those who cause harm to be removed from office.

"First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth." 1 Timothy 2:1

Ilt was a hot, steamy day in Haiti in 2013. The building used to house the visiting pastors had a pool that most would take advantage of after returning from ministry each day. As I did so, a pastor called out to me, asking if I was who he thought I was. He then said, "I'm Craig Cunningham from LaQuinta, California." I had no idea the impact that introduction would make.

Before leaving the airport the following day, Craig and I determined to become prayer partners. The plan was simple, just a 15 minute phone call each week which would include a quick catch up on life and us taking turns praying for each other. That decision bore unbelievable fruit in our lives over the next nine years. It was never forced. We missed weeks now and then. But, we consistently held each other up in prayer and as Craig often said to me, "Jeff, we have seen God answer so many prayers, haven't we?"

Craig succumbed to a four-year battle with cancer this week. Amazingly, he addressed his church one final time Sunday morning and within 20 hours was seeing Jesus face to face. He was my friend in a way no others have been. He knew what few knew about me, my family, my personal life and ministry. He prayed me through the most difficult year of my life in 2016. I was privileged to pray him through the ups and downs of his long battle with cancer. I knew his church and family from his vantage point, like few others did...

All because of prayer; together, consistent, intentional prayer. Praying with another pastor produces many things:

- Spiritual intimacy
- Encouragement
- Motivation
- · Comfort
- · Confidence

Do you need any of those things? Why not make one of the wisest decisions you can mid-year 2023...reach out to a fellow pastor in our network and begin a weekly 15 minute prayer relationship. Honestly, it will help you more than you can imagine.



2022-2023 YEAR-END REPORT



This year ASOM had 17
different cohorts meet in 12
different locations around
the state and online over the

This year we had over **250** students sign up for a total of **1,050** class registrations.

Students participated in **57** ministry practicums in AG churches across Arizona.




