
A Passion for Missions



Recently Sue and I attended General Council in Orlando. During the General Presbyters meeting we given important statistical data about our denomination. I was stunned to hear that in 2020 21% of our Assembly of God churches did not record a single decision for Christ. Could it be true that one-fifth of our churches didn't experience one conversion in the space of 365 days?

If this is true, then one might ask, "What happened to their passion to reach the lost?" Could a spirit of apathy have settled over a congregation to the point that they've laid aside the Lord's mandate and have become comfortable with just having church? God's heart must break when He sees His church not engaged in soul winning.

Jesus' mission on earth was "To seek and save the lost!" and this must be our priority as well. Preaching, worship and ministry programs are wonderful, but nothing should ever take the place of having a strong passion to witness spiritual conversions in every church throughout America. And the good news is that God wants to partner with us in this endeavor. As we see the Day of the Lord approaching, we need every church and every pastor to prioritize and engage in the ministry of evangelism.



This week I read an article about the missionary, He was and still is one of the most inspiring missionaries in history. He was called "God's Smuggler" because he brought the gospel behind the Iron Curtain during the Cold War and then went on to carry God's Word to many persecuted nations around the world.

He drastically surrendered his life to the Lord and then risked everything he had for the Great Commission. He spent his life bringing Bibles to the persecuted and spiritually lost, and Brother Andrew is still serving the persecuted church today. He continues to speak to Christians all over the world and has stirred up dissatisfaction in the hearts of those who have never considered preaching the good news, to go to the unreached and bring the gospel to where it is not.

Brother Andrew is an example of what can be done if we make a commitment to winning the lost at any cost. There are so many hungry hearts desiring to experience God's peace instead of the chaos and fear the world is offering.


As a personal example, our church sends out small evangelism teams of 4-6 people on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday nights and the favorable response to the message of the gospel is unbelievable. In 2020 they prayed with over 8,000 people to receive Christ in city parks and this year we have already seen 7,212 decisions for Christ. I say this, not to boast, but to encourage every pastor and church to once again engage in evangelism and take the good news of Christ's love to your community.

If one man like Brother Andrew can bring millions of bibles to the persecuted church, certainly we can lead one person to Jesus and eliminate the statistic of not having one decision for Christ. - THE GENERAL COUNCIL WILL PREPARE YOUR CERTIFICATE AND IT WILL BE GIVEN TO YOU AT THE ORDINATION SERVICE IN APRIL.

His death made me pause. Since he was an Anglican priest, I had not followed him closely. Yet, as I awoke and scrolled through my phone, the lead story on the website told of this man and his son's tragic deaths just days before. Moments like this can be very good for us. As I moved on with my early morning routine and headed to the airport for a speaking engagement, my thoughts were hijacked by his story.

It is staggering, isn't it? The thought of transitioning from this life—with all its temporal earthliness—into eternity with Christ in a split second. That's what we preach, right? That's what we challenge our people to consider and be prepared for, correct?Yet, the rawness of its reality transcends our common, everyday distracted thoughts.

In that moment, in light of our ministries, what will matter will be...

1. Our relationship with Jesus. The size of our church, perception of others' toward us, education, resumes, trophies, plaques, ACMRs...a lot of things will simply not matter at that moment.

- **2. His Kingdom, not ours.** The ministry comparisons and inner jealousies we have carried due to the size or scope of others' ministries, the rivalries that developed over time, the resumes, trophies, plaques, ACMRs (did I mention those?)...so much will not matter at that moment.
- **3.Our seeds.** Yes, our life's work will certainly matter. The untold amount of spiritual seed we scattered will continue to grow until Jesus splits the skies. How exciting!Our work will continue in collaboration with the watering and harvesting of others under the influence of God's economy.
- **4.Our loves.** By that I mean, those we have loved the most intimately. Most that we pastored over time will not be present at our eulogy. Yet, our family and closest of friends will seek to comfort their hearts through sharing collective thoughts of our existence.

I recently had a conversation with a pastor via text. It was brief, but painful. I sensed he found no joy in the success of another in ministry. It had to be his way, his ministry, his name, his...or it was nothing to him. My heart was sad, yet not overly condemning. I realized how hard it is often is for us to rejoice in the successes of another, unless it is that of a good friend or colleague. Otherwise, the deceitfulness of the flesh sabotages such moments with petty jealousy or rivalry.

This scenario was fresh in my mind as I read of the priest's passing. Thus, I weighed the situation in light of the prospects of eternity. It reminded me to strive after those four ideals each day: my relationship with Jesus, His kingdom (not mine), my seeds, and my loves.



National Speed the Light Day October 17, 2021

Arizona Youth Convention October 22-23, 2021



Over 40% of the people on Navajo Nation do not have access to running water, and much of the water they do have is contaminated. We have the opportunity to change that! Upon learning about the water crisis on Navajo Nation during the start of COVID, WorldServe committed to helping to meet a profound need for water, sanitation, hygiene, agriculture, and economic opportunities within the Navajo Nation. People on the Nation face water challenges rivaling those we typically see on the African continent and in the Global South. WorldServe is developing a comprehensive plan of action to address these challenges over the next decade, establishing long-term collaboration with powerful partners to bring clean water where it can be sustainably accessed and maintained over time. Speed the Light is a student-initiated, volunteer, charitable program that provides much-needed equipment to missionaries in over 180 countries around the world. WorldServe and Speed the Light's partnership is unique. Students in Arizona and across the United States are raising hundreds of thousands of dollars for water wells and challenging business people, athletes, churches and many others to match their giving! In 2019 alone, students funded 19 water projects and helped to purchase vital drilling equipment to expand in Kenya. Now it's time for new life in Navajo Nation!

Our Network Youth Director Griffin McGrath is doing an **Iron Man** to raise funds and awareness! "I'm doing a 70.3 IRONMAN on National Speed the Light Sunday (10.17.2021) because I want to live fearlessly and challenge a generation to believe God to provide through seemingly impossible situations. I want to see new life on Navajo Nation. As long as there's Jesus, there's hope."



As we continue to grow we are always looking for ways to improve the student experience. This includes finding top tier educators and finding new tools to help connect and equip students.







Pastor Thomas and his wife are from the war-torn county of the Democratic Republic of the Congo. In 2014, they barely escaped to a refugee camp in Uganda. After establishing a church in the camp, they arrived in Phoenix in 2017 with a handful of refugees. They did not realize that the Assemblies of God was not just in Africa, but existed in the USA as well! They were overjoyed last month when they discovered the Arizona Ministry Network. Today, they have just over 200 people rejoicing in the supernatural way God is moving among their people.





God helped us connect with IGLESIA NUEVO NACIMIENTO in Phoenix with Pastors Raymundo and Veronica Gordillos through an introduction from Pastor Raul Salgado. This vibrant and intentionally outward-focused church is reaching their community by extending the hand of Compassion and the hand of Evangelism in the streets around their church. They have come into our Network with 180 excited believers. They will be a Parent Affiliated Church with Revolution Ministries Church in Tolleson with Pastors Raul and Nora Salgado.

God helped us connect with IGLESIA AGUA EN EL DESIERTO in Tucson with Pastors Joe and Lesly Merlos. Pastors Merlos are missionaries sent by the Southern Pacific District of the Assemblies of God to plant churches in Arizona and around the world. This precious couple have bought land and equipment to start a church in Tucson. They have a 24-hour YouTube channel committed to worship, prayer and preaching. They are also the new pastors of our church in Sacaton on the Gila River Indian Reservation.



God is accelerating His Church! We are proud and grateful for our Hispanic churches and what is doing among our men. Pastor Raul Salgado and 11 other pastors have been praying and planning for a Spanish Men's Retreat at our campgrounds. With the blessing of our Network Men's Ministry Director, Dale Gray, they are using the brand new material for Men's Ministry in the local church, THE 360° MAN. They have travelled to different parts of the state and hosted meals while sharing this material for Hispanic Pastors and Leaders. God is accelerating His Church. The excitement among our Hispanic Pastors is amazing.

On October 8-9, 2021, there is a "Speak" Men's Retreat at Granite Hills Campground. If you have Spanish-speaking men in your church, they won't want to miss this power-packed retreat. Registration for the retreat is now open at azmensministry.org.


